## 1. ACT or WorkKeys results (NDCC 15.1-21-19.2)

- ◆ ND University System Admissions Placement Scores: Students with ACT English subtest scores of 14-17 or approved equivalents may take ENGL 110 if co-enrolled in a developmental English course when a co-enrollment option is made available by the student's home campus, or after they have passed a developmental writing course with a passing grade equivalent of "C" or higher. Students with an English subtest score less than 14 must complete a developmental course prior to taking ENGL 110.

- ◆ The importance of parallel planning (having multiple post high school education/career plans) when the student changes their mind:
  - ❖ Number of years of postsecondary needed
  - ❖ Similar career opportunities with different or transferable coursework requirements
  - ❖ Learning style(s)
  - ❖ Career planning services available on campus (usually at no charge)
