

School district responsibility for student costs

The following tables identify the school district responsibility (cost cap) for the education of resident students. School districts incur the full cost based on an approved contract and are reimbursed for amount in excess of the cost cap. The Department of Public Instruction will pay the full cost for students determined to be the responsibility of the state.
