




ELL Workshop

A full day of training for **ELL teachers and K-12 certified staff serving ELL students** which includes background on Foldables and their uses, research behind Foldables and relevant ELL strategies and how the two are connected. The day is 90% hands-on, with teachers creating their own examples as they are led by the presenter throughout the presentation. Participants will create no less than 15 different folds, and have some time for application and sharing. **There is a strong emphasis on vocabulary tools, since vocabulary is the greatest predictor of academic success, but some of the day is also devoted to interactive notebooking and independent Foldable projects.** A full day of training includes multiple strategies for Foldable novices or experienced folds to use in the classroom; we divide the day around two “brain breaks,” one in the morning and another in the afternoon, and a lunch break so that there is some time for sharing ideas is included throughout the day.


