This endorsement is available on a voluntary basis to teachers licensed to teach elementary grades 1-8 or to specialty areas licensed to teach grades K-12. Elementary teachers licensed to teach grades 1-6 must complete this endorsement to teach grades 7-8. This endorsement is mandatory for teachers licensed for grades 7-12 to qualify for work with grades 5-6 in the subject field(s) of their licensure and voluntary for work with grade 7-8 students.

Re-education Plan: List the coursework in your educational plan and return a copy of this form to ESPB for approval.

Endorsement Request and Verification: Once you have completed the requirements, request this endorsement be added to your license by returning this form to ESPB along with your official transcripts and verification of experience.

Fees: If you wish to add this endorsement between renewals, a non-refundable fee of \$75 must be enclosed. There is no additional fee to add this endorsement at your normal license renewal time.

Timeline: This endorsement must be completed prior to or within two calendar years of your first contracted employment as a middle school teacher in North Dakota. This endorsement does not change your regular license renewal date.
