

## CREA New Teacher Support Network

### WELCOME TO THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR!

The Central Regional Education Association has set forth an initiative to develop and implement a New Teacher Support Program for first-year teachers employed by the school districts that are members of CREA. The New Teacher Support Program provides first year teachers with a professional growth opportunity, ongoing support/guidance, and professional dialogue with peers from around the region.

#### What is involved in participating in the New Teacher Network?

The CREA New Teacher Support Network will consist of two full day face-to-face support sessions. In an effort to make travel more convenient for participants from within the region, face-to-face program sessions will be held in Minot and Bismarck. Between each of the full day meetings are three 1 hour check-ins. These check-ins will be offered electronically or face-to-face dependent upon participant need or choice. Participants will engage in quality training and collaboration on timely topics lead by Central Regional Education Association leaders. There is no cost to participants to attend the CREA New Teacher Support Network.
