# SharePoint Roadmap

Microsoft has announced that there will be no further SharePoint Foundation upgrades for on premise solutions. The 2013 version that is currently in use will be the last version supported. SharePoint Enterprise will continue on its normal upgrade patterns.

We anticipate rate changes occurring in the 17-19 biennium for current Foundation users that will allow them to migrate to the Enterprise platform. We plan to contact each agency and set up an migration plan during the 2017-2019 Biennium.
