This diverse and vibrant industry produces a wide array of products, thanks largely to the hard work and use of multiple production practices by our 30,000 farmers and ranchers. We lead the nation in the production of many commodities, such as spring wheat, durum, canola, dry beans and honey.

Examples of the local foods movement—farmers markets, food co-ops, community-supported agriculture (CSAs), community orchards, roadside stands and pick-your-own gardens—are growing in numbers and size across our state.



# Glossary

Please use this glossary to find definitions of terms found in this directory. All definitions are taken from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

<b>Aquaponics</b>	A system combining aquaculture with hydroponics in which aquatic animals and hydroponically-grown plants are cultivated together.
<b>Certified Organic</b>	Organic food is produced without: antibiotics; growth hormones; most conventional pesticides; petroleum-based fertilizers or sewage sludge-based fertilizers; bioengineering; or ionizing radiation. USDA certification is required before a product can be labeled “organic.” Companies, including restaurants, that handle or process organic food must be certified also.
<b>Community-Supported Agriculture (CSA)</b>	A community of individuals who pledge support to a farm operation with the growers and consumers providing mutual support and sharing the risks and benefits of food production. Members pledge in advance to cover the anticipated costs of the farm operation and farmer’s salary. In return, they receive shares in the farm’s bounty throughout the growing season.
<b>Farmers Market</b>	A multi-stall market at which farmer-producers sell agricultural products directly to the general public at a central or fixed location, particularly fresh fruit and vegetables (but also meat products, dairy products, and/or grains).
<b>Free Range Husbandry</b>	A system of animal management where animals are not confined and can freely roam and forage over a large area of open land.
<b>Grass-Fed Livestock</b>	Meat animals raised primarily on ranges rather than in a feedlot.
<b>Hydroponic</b>	The growing of plants in a soilless environment where nutrients are provided by the application of nutrient solutions.
<b>Pesticide</b>	Any substance or mixture of substances intended for preventing, destroying, repelling, or mitigating any pest.
<b>U-Pick</b>	A farm that allows customers to harvest their own produce, usually small berries.
