- \_\_\_\_\_ A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and an importation permit number from the North Dakota State Veterinarian's office must be obtained prior to entry.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Animal(s) must have permanent official individual identification and the identifications listed on the CVI.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If Canadian origin, animal(s) must have the CAN brand (2"-3"), high on the right hip.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Animal(s) must have a negative brucellosis and, if required, tuberculosis test within 30 days prior to entry.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Animal(s) shall be isolated upon arrival until they are retested for brucellosis within 30-60 days after arrival.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Animal(s) shall remain on your premises for three years or if sale is necessary they can be sold "slaughter only" during that time, with prior notice to the State Board of Animal Health (Board). Following this three-year period there will be no further restrictions upon these animals.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Animal(s) shall be made available to an agent of the Board for inspection with prior notification and during normal working hours.
- \_\_\_\_\_ An annual inventory report which describes the current status of the animal(s) is due on or before January 1 of each year for the three year period and shall be provided to the Board.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If approved, animal(s) shall be in the state within 60 days of approval or a new request must be submitted.

\*\*Violation of these criteria may result in an action by the Board and up to a \$5000 fine.

Upon sale of animal, brand inspectors may require a copy of the Canadian CVI for proof of ownership.
