NARRATIVE: The driver of a 1995 Ford F150 was traveling westbound on 44th St SE. The driver of the Ford was distracted by the passenger's mobile device. The driver of the Ford lost control on the wet gravel roadway. The Ford entered the north ditch and overturned. The driver and passenger sustained minor injuries. The driver was placed under arrest for driving under the influence of alcohol. The passenger was placed under arrest for minor of consumption of alcohol. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
