Injury Crash Hwy 1806 MP 60 – south of Mandan, ND

What: Injury Crash

Where: Hwy 1806, mile marker 60 - 9 Miles South of Mandan

When: 08/05/2020 at approximately 2323 hrs

Road Conditions: Dry. Construction area.

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Morton County Sheriff's Department, Metro Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2015 Subaru Forester

Driver No. 1: Male - 23yrs old - Bismarck, ND – Serious Injuries

Restraints: side airbags deployed – no seat belt

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE:

The 2015 Subaru was traveling northbound on Highway 1806 near mile marker 60. The vehicle ran off the east shoulder and the driver over-corrected. The vehicle crossed the southbound lane, entered the west ditch and rolled; coming to rest in the west ditch. The driver was ejected from the vehicle. The driver was transported to CHI – St Alexius Hospital in Bismarck, ND.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
