NARRATIVE: The Chevrolet Silverado was traveling west bound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 305. The driver lost control and the UHaul trailer began to fishtail. The driver veered right and entered north ditch of Interstate 94 and overturned. The Chevrolet came to rest on it's passenger side facing East. The male driver and female passenger were transported to CHI Mercy Hospital in Valley City by Valley City Ambulance. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
