## **Pursuit Injury Crash in McKenzie County**

What: Injury

Where: Hwy 22 MM 136(20 miles north of Killdeer)

When: 2/15/20 at 11:13 P.M.

**Road Conditions: Good** 

Weather Conditions: Snowing

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

Agencies Involved: McKenzie County Sheriff Department, ND Highway Patrol, Mandaree

Ambulance, Three Affiliated Tribes Police Department (TAT)

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2015 Ford Fusion

**Driver No. 1:** Miranda Holm, 20-year-old female from Williston, Serious Injury

**Restraints:** no seatbelt used, airbag deployed

**Charges:** Pending

**NARRATIVE:** Vehicle 1 was being pursued by TAT for exceeding the speed limit at over 115 mph. TAT had been pursuing the vehicle for approximately 3 miles when the vehicle failed to negotiate a curve and drove off the roadway. The vehicle rolled and came to rest in the east ditch facing south on its passenger side. Driver was transported to CHI St. Alexius in Dickinson for serious injuries. Crash is still under investigation by the Highway Patrol
