Two-Vehicle Injury Crash Near Manvel

What: Injury

Where: northbound Interstate 29, at Manvel, ND

When: 02/25/2020 at approximately 9:27 PM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: 2-vehicle

Type of Crash: Head-on

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Grand Forks Sheriff's Office, Walsh County Sheriff's Office, Manvel Fire, Altru Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2002 Toyota Echo
Driver No. 1: Adam Bergman; male; age 34 years; of Alvarado, MN; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Seat belt in use, air bags deployed
Charges: DUI

Vehicle No. 2: 2015 Honda Pilot
Driver No. 2: Marcia Olson; female; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Seat belt in use, air bag deployed
Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Juvenile female; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Seat belt in use, air bags deployed

NARRATIVE: Bergman was driving the Toyota south in the northbound lanes of Interstate 29. Olson was driving the Honda north in the correct lanes of Interstate 29 when she

encountered Bergman's vehicle traveling the wrong way. The vehicles met head-on. Olson took evasive action but the front of Bergman's vehicle struck the front left of the Honda.

All three occupants were transported by ambulance to Altru Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Northbound traffic on Interstate 29 was diverted onto US Highway 81 at Manvel for approximately 1 hour 15 minutes until the scene could be cleared.

The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
