## **Cement Truck Rollover**

What: Minor injury rollover crash

Where: I-29 northbound exit to I-94 westbound

When: 2/5/20 at 08:52

Road Conditions: dry

Weather Conditions: clear, sunny

Crash Involvement: single vehicle/highway sign

Type of Crash: Rollover striking a highway sign

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo FD, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1:2017 Mack cement truckDriver No. 1:Sean Riedl, 50 years old of Fargo, NDRestraints:SeatbeltCharges:Care Required

**NARRATIVE:** A loaded Kost Materials cement truck was northbound on I-29 when it entered the exit ramp (loop style ramp) onto westbound I-94. The driver entered the curve too quickly and the truck rolled over onto the roadway, slid into the ditch and struck a highway sign. The driver was transported to Sanford for minor injuries. The driver was cited for Care Required. The exit ramp from I-29 northbound to I-94 westbound was closed for about an hour and a half to allow for the recovery of the truck.
