NARRATIVE:

Maness was traveling westbound on US Highway 2 in the 2020 Diamond multi-passenger bus. Murray was traveling northbound on 41st Avenue NE in the 2012 Freightliner garbage truck. Murray failed to yield right of way to Maness while crossing the westbound lanes of traffic on US Highway 2. Maness struck the right side of Murray's vehicle behind the cab of the Freightliner causing it to rotate and overturn onto its left side.



Maness was transported by Rugby EMS to Heart of America Medical Center in Rugby for injuries sustained in the crash.

The bus came to rest on its wheels facing northwest in the north shoulder of the outside lane of US Highway 2. The Freightliner came to rest on its left side facing south on 41st Avenue NE.

There were no passengers on the bus and the bus was being delivered to Regina, Saskatchewan from Oswego, Kansas.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
