Stolen vehicle/Pursuit **UPDATED**

NARRATIVE: At approximately 7:36 pm Troopers located a stolen Chevrolet pickup on Interstate 94 westbound at MM 342. The Troopers attempted a traffic stop but the pickup failed to stop, and a pursuit ensued. The Chevrolet pickup traveled west on I-94 at speeds up to 100 MPH. The pickup exited I-94 (MM 331) at Casselton, drove thru the intersection and went down into the northwest ditch getting stuck in a small slough. The driver who was identified as **James Schaan, 35 YOA from Mandan North Dakota** was removed from the vehicle without incident and placed under arrest for the following charges: Possession on a controlled substance with the intent to deliver, possession of drug paraphernalia, driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs, possession of stolen vehicle and possession of controlled substance (personal use) and theft of property. Cass County Sheriffs office assisted with the pursuit and is investigating the stolen vehicle and may have additional charges.
