NARRATIVE: The Ford was traveling east bound on Interstate 94 towards Fargo. The driver of the Ford observed an Isuzu ahead of him in the right-hand lane. The driver of the Ford struck the rear-end of the Isuzu. The driver of the Ford and the driver of the Isuzu were not



injured. The passenger of the Ford was transported by FM Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo to be treated for her injuries sustained in the crash. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
