McIntosh County Crash Update

What: Serious Injury

Where: 63rd Ave SE (18 miles NE of Ashley, ND)

When: 06/22/2020 at 1:45 P.M.

Road Conditions: Normal conditions, gravel roadway

Weather Conditions: Daylight

Crash Involvement: One vehicle rollover

Type of Crash: Ran off roadway

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, McIntosh County Sheriff's Department,

Ashley Ambulance, Ashley Rural Fire, and Avera Careflight.

Vehicle No. 1: 2006 Mack truck

Driver No. 1: Christopher Bauer, 60 years old, Ellendale, ND, serious injury

Restraints: Unknown

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: The Mack truck was traveling northbound on 63rd Ave SE. The roadway was controlled travel due to the narrow roadway, and construction equipment in the area. A line of traffic was traveling south bound on 63rd Ave SE, when the Mack truck met the line of vehicles. Due to the dry conditions, a large amount of dust was in the air reducing visibility. The Mack truck ran off the roadway and entered the east ditch of 63rd Ave SE. The Mack truck rolled onto the passenger side and came to rest in the slough of the east ditch. Bauer was flown by Avera Careflight to St. Luke's hospital in Aberdeen, SD to be treated for his injuries sustained in the crash. The crash is under the investigation of the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
