## **2 Vehicle Injury Crash South of Grand Forks**

**What:** Injury

**Where:** Grand Forks County Road 17 and County Road 6, 2 miles South of Grand Forks

**When:** May 23, 2020 @ 23:19 (11:19 PM)

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Dark not lighted, clear

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle v. Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Right Angle

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Grand Forks County Sheriff's Office, Altru Ambulance Service

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2019 Toyota Highlander

**Driver No. 1:** Ava Miller, 16 yo, Grand Forks, ND, female, not injured

**Restraints:** seatbelt

**Charges:** disregarded stop sign

**Passenger No. 1:** Emily Robson, 17 yo, Grand Forks, female, not injured

**NARRATIVE:** The Highlander was south bound on Grand Forks County Rd 17 at about 55 mph. The BMW was east bound on Cnty Rd 6. At the intersection of Cnty 17 and Cnty 6 the Highlander failed to stop at the intersection and was struck in the passenger side by BMW. Minor injuries were reported by the passengers of the Highlander. 1 person was transported to Altru due to injuries sustained in the crash. Miller was cited for disregarding a stop sign. The crash is still under investigation by the NDHP.
