Memorial Bridge (Bismarck-Mandan) Motorcycle Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Memorial Bridge between Bismarck, ND and Mandan, ND (I-94 Business Loop mile marker 921)

When: 05/25/2020 around 1136 hrs

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Overcast

Crash Involvement: Two Motorcycles

Type of Crash: Rear-End

Agencies Involved: ND Highway Patrol and Metro Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2006 Harley Davidson Motorcycle

Driver No. 1: Male - 61 years old - Mandan, ND – Serious injuries

Restraints: No Helmet

Charges: Under Investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2009 Victory Motorcycle

Driver No. 2: Male – 59 years old – Mandan, ND – No injuries

Restraints: No Helmet

Charges: None

NARRATIVE:

A 2006 Harley Davidson Motorcycle driven by a 61-year-old Mandan man was traveling westbound on the Memorial Bridge as part of a group ride for Memorial Day. A 2009 Victory Motorcycle driven by a 59-year-old Mandan man was also traveling westbound on the Memorial Bridge as part of a group ride for Memorial Day. The Victory Motorcycle was

traveling in front of the Harley Davidson. The Victory motorcycle stopped as traffic in front of it had stopped. The Harley Davidson rear-ended the Victory. The driver of the Harley Davidson was ejected from the motorcycle. The driver of the Victory was uninjured. The driver of the Harley Davidson was transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital for serious injuries.

Neither driver was wearing a helmet. This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
