Morton County Fatal Crash – Names Released

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Hwy 1806 mm 34.5 approx. 35 miles south of Mandan

When: 5/6/20 at 1:20 pm CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/vehicle

Type of Crash: Angle

Vehicle No. 1: 2007 Dodge Durango

Driver No. 1: Terri Yellowhammer, Female, 28, Fort Yates, minor injuries

Restraints: Seat belt

Charges: Under investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 1993 Dodge Ram

Driver No. 2: Conan Magilke, Male, 51, Lampasas, TX, fatal injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not worn

Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: Angela Magilke, Female, 48, Lampasas, TX, minor injuries

Restraints: Seat belt

NARRATIVE: The Dodge Durango driven by Yellowhammer was traveling southbound on 1806 from Bismarck to Fort Yates. The Dodge Ram driven by Magilke was traveling northbound on 1806 from the Solen area to Fort Rice. Yellowhammer failed to negotiate a

curve and the Durango traveled off the west shoulder of the road. Yellowhammer overcorrected and the Durango crossed the center line into the northbound lane, striking the Ram. Both vehicles entered the east ditch and rolled. Conan Magilke died on scene due to injuries sustained in the crash. Yellowhammer and Angela Magilke were transported to Sanford Hospital.
