Restraints: In back of ambulance, caring for the patient

Passenger No. 2: Jaadon Ries, 21 years old, Sisseton, SD-minor injuries

Restraints: In back of ambulance, caring for the patient

Passenger No. 3: 34 year old male, Sisseton, SD-unknown injuries

Restraints: Patient in back of ambulance

NARRATIVE: The Grant Robert ambulance was transporting a patient from Sisseton, SD to Sanford Hospital in Fargo. The ambulance turned southbound on Veteran's Boulevard from westbound I-94 with the emergency lights and siren activated. The driver lost control of the ambulance on the icy overpass bridge deck and struck the west curb. The ambulance rolled onto its side. Both crew members in the back of the ambulance received minor injuries. The

patient was sedated and it is unknown if he suffered any further injuries as a result of the crash.
