**Williston Fatal Crash**

**What:** Fatal Crash

**Where:** 34<sup>th</sup> St. W and 1<sup>st</sup> Ave W in Williston, ND

**When:** September 17, 2020 at approximately 2222hrs CST

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** One motorcycle and one SUV

**Type of Crash:** Angle

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol and Williston PD

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2006 Kawasaki Ninja

**Driver No. 1:** Jacob Hale, male, 34, Williston, ND; Fatal.

**Restraints:** no helmet worn

**Charges:** none

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2008 GMC Yukon

**Driver No. 2:** Andrea Bredwick, female, 30, Williston, ND; not injured.

**Restraints:** Seat belt worn

**Charges:** none

**Passenger No. 1:** Cortney Gajewski, female, 23, Williston, ND; not injured.

**Restraints:** Seat belt worn

**NARRATIVE:** Hale was traveling westbound on 34<sup>th</sup> Street W while Bredwick was traveling northbound on 1<sup>st</sup> Ave W in Williston, ND. Hale struck the rear side of Bredwick's vehicle as he disregarded a stop sign at the intersection of 34<sup>th</sup> Street W and 1<sup>st</sup> Ave W. Hale was pronounced dead on scene due to fatal injuries sustained from the crash. Hale was not wearing a safety helmet. Bredwick and Gajewski were uninjured. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
