Four Injured in Off-Highway Vehicle Crash

What: Injury

Where: 36th Street NE, approximately 3.5 miles southwest of Northwood, ND

When: 09/09/2020, approximately 3:00 PM

Road Conditions: Good, gravel surface

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Overturn

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Grand Forks County Sheriff's Office, Northwood Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2015 Polaris Ranger side-by-side Off-Highway Vehicle
Driver No. 1: juvenile female; age 12; of Northwood, ND; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Neither seat belt nor helmet in use
Charges: Under investigation

Passenger No. 1: juvenile female; age 13; of Northwood, ND; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Seat belt in use, no helmet in use

Passenger No. 2: juvenile female; age 13; of Northwood, ND; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Neither seat belt nor helmet in use

Passenger No. 3: juvenile male; age 13; of Northwood, ND; non-life-threatening injuries
Restraints: Neither seat belt nor helmet in use

NARRATIVE: The 12-year-old juvenile female was driving the Polaris north on 36th Street NE. Near 1st Avenue NE, the driver lost control of the vehicle, which entered the west ditch and



overturned. All four occupants were transported to Northwood Deaconess Health Center in Northwood, ND, with what are believed to be non-life-threatening injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
