Road Conditions: Concrete Roadway Surface - Slush/Snow/Wet

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, Snow

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Angle Collision

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Ramsey County Sheriff Department, Camp Grafton Civilian & Military Personnel, Lake Region Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2008 Dodge Grand Caravan

Driver No. 1: Joshua Sailor; 20; Devils Lake, North Dakota; non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: None; Side Airbag Deployment

Passenger No. 1: Joy Bailey; 18; Devils Lake, North Dakota; non-life-threatening injuries

NARRATIVE: Sailor was traveling westbound on Newgard Drive traveling too fast for the existing roadway conditions. Sailor lost control of Vehicle 1 and entered into a clockwise skid. Vehicle 1 left the traveled portion of the roadway and entered the north ditch striking a tree. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
