## McKenzie County Injury Crash

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** Hwy 85 MM 124, 15 miles South of Watford City

**When:** April 14, 2021 5:45 PM

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Cloudy

**Crash Involvement:** One Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, McKenzie County Sheriff's Office, Watford City Fire Dept, Grassy Butte Fire Dept, McKenzie County Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2016 Ford pickup

**Driver No. 1:** Richard Hall, male, 60, Grand Junction, CO, injured

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Charges:** Under Investigation

**NARRATIVE:** Hall was traveling northbound on Hwy 85. Hall's vehicle ran off the roadway into the West ditch, traveled approximately 100 yards, and vaulted off a 30 foot cliff. After the vehicle landed, it rolled and came to rest on its top. Hall sustained serious, non-life threatening injuries. He was transported by ambulance to the McKenzie County Medical Center. This crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
