Where: Highway 52 MM 251 (1 mile north of Buchanan)

When: April 18, 2021, 0500 AM

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear with high wind

Crash Involvement: One Vehicle

Type of Crash: Roll over

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Stutsman County Sheriff, Jamestown Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2022 Volvo pulling 4 axle tanker

Driver No. 1: Dakota Hatch, 27; Grand Forks, ND; Injury


Restraints: Seat Belt

Charges: Care required

NARRATIVE: The Volvo was traveling southbound on Highway 52 with a load of dairy milk. The driver fell asleep and left the roadway entering the west ditch. Upon entering the ditch, the combination rolled. The vehicle came to rest on the passenger side. The driver of the Volvo was transported by ambulance to Jamestown Regional Medical Center for injuries sustained in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
