Where: Walsh County Road 19 ~ ¾ of a Mile West of Fordville, North Dakota

When: August 7, 2021 @ 8:17 P.M.

Road Conditions: Dry, Good, Paved Roadway Surface

Weather Conditions: Clear, Dusk

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Fixed Object

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Walsh County Sheriff Department, Walsh County Fire & Rescue

Vehicle No. 1: 2016 Ford F-350

Driver No. 1: Nicholas Lundquist; Male; 28; Langdon, North Dakota; Serious Injuries

Restraints: Unknown - Front Airbag Deployment

Charges: Driving Under the Influence

NARRATIVE: Lundquist was traveling westbound on County Road 19 in rural Walsh County west of Fordville. Lundquist crossed over the eastbound lane of traffic on County Road 19, struck a bridge guardrail, and sustained serious injuries. Lundquist was life-flighted to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks from the crash scene for injuries sustained in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
