



North Dakota Highway Patrol Recruitment Event

The North Dakota Highway Patrol is hosting a recruitment event on Jan. 26 from 4:00-8:00PM at the LETA in Bismarck. The recruitment event is an opportunity for individuals interested in a law enforcement career to learn about a career path with the North Dakota Highway Patrol. Troopers from across the state and administrative personnel will be available to answer questions about working for the patrol; training opportunities; and options to participate in NDHP's specialized programs. In addition, HR staff will be available to answer questions about the application process and salary and benefits. Potential applicants will have the opportunity to try out the NDHP Critical Task Assessment (CTA) fitness test. Passing this physical fitness assessment is one of the requirements for serving as an officer with the NDHP.

The recruitment event is scheduled at the Law Enforcement Training Academy, 1320 Shafer St, Bismarck. Members of the media are welcome to join and/or participate in the fitness test.
