NARRATIVE: A NDDOT snowplow truck pulling a plow trailer was pre-treating the roads for icy conditions traveling southbound on I-29 from MM 172. The plow truck had emergency lights activated and was laying the pre-treat liquid on the road when it was struck from behind by the Honda Accord. The driver of the Honda suffered fatal injuries from the crash and was taken to Unity Hospital. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
