## **Injury Crash - Benson County, North Dakota**

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** ND Highway 30 @ Mile Marker 123.60 ~ 5 Miles South of Maddock, North Dakota

**When:** January 24, 2021 @ 1:30 A.M.

**Road Conditions:** Asphalt Roadway Surface - Dry

**Weather Conditions:** Cloudy

**Crash Involvement:** Single Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Ran Off Roadway

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol

**Vehicle No. 1:** 1998 Chevrolet Tahoe

**Driver No. 1:** Ross Lindgren; 37; Maddock, North Dakota; non-life-threatening injuries

**Restraints:** None

**Charges:** Duty upon striking highway fixtures or other property

**NARRATIVE:** Lindgren was southbound when he failed to negotiate a left curve north of a bridge crossing over the Sheyenne River. Lindgren left the roadway and entered the west ditch striking a highway fixture maintained by the ND Department of Transportation. After striking the highway fixture, Lindgren vaulted over the north bank of the Sheyenne River, striking the iced over river bottom. Lindgren was transported to Saint Aloisius Medical Center in Harvey by his spouse in a privately owned motor vehicle.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
