What: Injury Crash

Where: Burdick Expressway Way (1/4-mile NE of Highway 2) in Minot, ND

When: January 30, 2021 at approximately 2136hrs CST

Road Conditions: Ice/Frost

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Two Vehicle

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Minot Police Department, Ward County Sheriff's Office, Minot Fire, and Minot Community Ambulance.

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 Ford Explorer

Operator No. 1: Male, 29, Minot, ND; injured.

Restraints: Safety belt worn

Charges: Under investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 2013 Honda Pilot

Operator No. 2: Juvenile Male, 15, Des Lacs, ND; injured.

Restraints: Safety belt worn

Charges: Under investigation

Passenger No. 1: Juvenile Female, 14, Minot, ND; injured.

Restraints: Safety belt worn

NARRATIVE: The Explorer was traveling northeast on Burdick Expressway W in Minot, ND. The Pilot was leaving a private business on Burdick Expressway W. The Pilot started to initiate a left turn onto Burdick Expressway W when the Explorer struck the side of the Pilot. All

occupants were transported to Trinity Hospital for potential injuries suffered from the crash. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
