NDHP Promotes Bohn to Sergeant

NARRATIVE: Colonel Brandon Solberg announces the promotion of Trooper Jeremiah Bohn to Sergeant and reassignment as a regional sergeant to the Northwest region.

Bohn joined the North Dakota Highway Patrol after spending time as a Marine from 1994 to 2001 and was present during the embassy bombing in Tanzania in 1998. After serving in the Marines he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice and Sociology from Minnesota State University, Moorhead, in 2006. He then attended the Highway Patrol Academy, graduating in June 2007. Following graduation, he was stationed in Bismarck as a traffic enforcement trooper where he currently serves.

Sgt. Bohn received a promotional certificate and chevrons at a ceremony at the Law Enforcement Training Academy, Bismarck, on June 1. He begins his duties as a Northwest regional sergeant, stationed in Minot, effective June 1.
