## **Wind Causes Tractor-Trailer Overturn near Reynolds, ND**

**What:** Minor injury

**Where:** Interstate 29, approximately 3 miles north of Reynolds, ND **When:** 06/11/2021,  
approximately 5:25 AM

**Road Conditions:** Wet

**Weather Conditions:** Thunderstorms, rain, heavy winds

**Crash Involvement:** single vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2020 Freightliner truck pulling empty dry van trailer  
**Driver No. 1:** Brian Dueck; male; age 37; of Winnipeg, MB; minor injuries  
**Restraints:** Seat belt worn  
**Charges:** None

**NARRATIVE:** Dueck was driving the Freightliner south on Interstate 29. Strong, gusty west winds caused the empty vehicle to tip into the median onto its driver side. The truck came to rest partially in the median and partially in the inside lane of the northbound lanes. Dueck sustained minor injuries and was not transported for medical attention.

Interstate 29 remained open, but northbound traffic was reduced to one lane until the vehicle could be removed.
