Stark County Sobriety Checkpoint and Saturation Patrols

NARRATIVE: Impaired driving continues to be a public safety concern throughout North Dakota. As of June 13, 2021, there have been 39 fatalities on North Dakota roadways. Thirty two percent (11) of the fatalities have been alcohol related. On June 26, 2021, the North Dakota Highway Patrol will conduct a sobriety checkpoint and saturation patrols in Stark County during Roughrider Days. The increase in traffic provides law enforcement an opportunity to be more visible to help encourage drivers to make the responsible decision and designate a sober driver. Alcohol related crashes are preventable. Zero Fatalities, Zero Excuses.
