Mandan, ND rollover crash / I-94 Exit 156 temporary closure

What: Injury Crash

Where: I-94 Exit 156 in Mandan

When: June 21, 2021 at 10:38 A.M. hours

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single-Vehicle

Type of Crash: Roll-Over

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Metro Ambulance, Mandan PD, Mandan Fire

Vehicle No. 1:	2013 Hino Straight Truck
Driver No. 1:	Jakob Lorenzetti, 23-years-old male, Fargo, ND, injured
Restraints:	Seat belt worn
Charges:	Under Investigation

Passenger No. 1: Andrew Ellingson, 26-year-old male, Fargo, ND, injured Restraints: Seat belt not worn

NARRATIVE: The 2013 Hino was traveling westbound on I-94 and took Exit 156 (cloverleaf) to merge onto the Mandan Expressway in Morton County. The vehicle failed to negotiate the curve, drove off the roadway to the left and overturned onto its driver side. Lorenzetti sustained non-life-threatening injuries. The passenger (Andrew Ellingson) was transported by ambulance and treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

Exit 156 was closed for approximately 2 hours until the truck could be towed and the scene cleared.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
