1 Vehicle Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: I-29 mm 65, Main Ave exit, Fargo

When: 6/22/2021 at 9:56 PM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear, dusk

Crash Involvement: single vehicle

Type of Crash: Fixed Object

Agencies Involved: Fargo PD, Fargo FD, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2008 Chevrolet Impala

Driver No. 1: 25 year old male, Fargo, ND seriously injured

Restraints: No seatbelt, airbag deployed

Charges: Driving under the influence, unauthorized use of a motor vehicle

NARRATIVE: Vehicle was northbound on I-29 at a high rate of speed. The driver veered suddenly toward the Main Ave exit. The driver lost control of the vehicle and struck the concrete base of an overhead sign support. The driver was ejected from the vehicle and was seriously injured. The driver was transported to Sanford hospital where he is in stable condition. The vehicle was reported as stolen. The driver was charged with driving under the influence.
