June 3 Barnes County Fatality Crash Update

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Interstate 94 eastbound, mile marker 276; 5 miles west of Sanborn

When: June 3, 2021 @ approx. 12:30 p.m.

Road Conditions: Good, dry

Weather Conditions: Sunny, Winds W @ 15 mph

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs. Semi

Type of Crash: Sideswipe and rollover

Agencies Involved: ND Highway Patrol, Barnes County SO, Sanborn Fire, Valley City Rural Fire, Barnes County Ambulance

NARRATIVE: The two vehicles above were both eastbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 276. Truck/trailer was in the right lane and had slowed for a grass fire in the south ditch. The Jeep was overtaking the semi in the left lane. The Jeep drifted over the center line and sideswiped the drive tires of the truck. The Jeep then lost control, entered the median, and overturned, coming to rest in the westbound lanes. Jacobson, who was not wearing a seatbelt, was ejected from the vehicle. Barton, who was wearing a seatbelt,

was injured with non-life threatening injuries and transported to a hospital and later released. Goodroad, driver of the semi, was not injured. Interstate 94 traffic was diverted to the overhead for approximately two hours while the scene was investigated. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
