Expressway Bridge Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 810 MM1.1 (Expressway Bridge Westbound)

When: March 14th, 2021 at 9:42 p.m.

Road/Weather Conditions: Normal/Clear

Crash Involvement: Two Vehicles

Type of Crash: Rear End

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Bismarck Police Department, Bismarck Fire Department, Metro

Vehicle No. 1: 2016 Chevrolet Impala

Driver No. 1: Alexis Albers, 22, Mandan, not injured

Restraints: Seatbelt - Airbags deployed

Charges: Under Investigation

Vehicle No. 2: 1989 Buick Electra Park Avenue

Driver No. 2: Anderson Begay, 43, Ganado, AZ, Injured **Passenger No. 2:** Grace Begay, 50, Ganado, AZ, Injured

Restraints: Driver: Seatbelt – Passenger: No Seatbelt – Airbags not deployed

Charges: Under Investigation

NARRATIVE: Anderson Begay was traveling westbound on the Expressway bridge in the right lane when his vehicle sustained a mechanical issue, causing the vehicle to stall on the bridge deck. Alexis Albers was traveling westbound and came upon the stalled Buick. Albers' vehicle rear-ended the Begay's vehicle. Both vehicles came to rest on the bridge, blocking the right lane. Anderson and Grace Begay were transported by Metro Ambulance due to injuries sustained in the crash. Alexis Albers was not injured in the crash. The westbound lanes of the Expressway were shut down for approximately 1 hour.



This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
