Where: Highway 85, mile marker 178, 6 miles south of Williston

NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1 was traveling from Watford City to Williston northbound on Highway 85; vehicle 2 was traveling northbound from Alexander to Williston northbound on Highway 85. The semi and trailer slowed to around 45 mph on the four-lane highway for deer in the ditch and another vehicle that was on the shoulder with hazard lights on. The Geo Prizm was traveling at highway speeds when it rear-ended the trailer. Driver of the Prizm was flown to



Minot for injuries sustained in the crash; the passenger was transported to Williston injuries sustained in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
