NARRATIVE: Engebretson was driving the Dodge Ram north on Dakota Drive. Larson was driving the Journey east on North Dakota Highway 5. At the intersection with Highway 5, Engebretson attempted to turn left to travel west on Highway 5. The front left of the Ram struck the front of the Journey. Engebretson was uninjured. Martha Larson was transported by

ambulance to CHI St. Alexius Hospital in Devils Lake, ND, with minor injuries. Olivia Larson was uninjured.
