Williams County Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 2 mm27 (1 mile N of Williston)

When: May 16, 2021 at approximately 1333hrs CST

Weather Conditions: Sunny

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle crash

Type of Crash: fall/jumped from MV

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williams County Sheriff's Department, and Williams County Fire and EMS

Vehicle No. 1: 2015 Honda CRF450

Operator No. 1: Brendon Cunningham, male, 22, Williston, ND; injured.

Restraints: Helmet worn

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: Cunningham was riding roadside in the northbound ditch on his 2015 Honda CRF450 near Highway 2 mm27. Cunningham drove over a hillcrest at high speeds causing him to go airborne. Cunningham purposely separated from his dirt bike while airborne. He sustained injuries from the crash and was transported to a nearby hospital for treatment. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
