

## Bus Crash – I-94 near Crystal Springs

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** I-94, MM 222 near Crystal Springs

**When:** 11/12/2021 9:35 am CST

**Road Conditions:** Ice covered

**Weather Conditions:** Windy, blowing snow

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle/Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Angle

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP and Kidder County Sheriff's Office

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2011 Vanhool T2145 Bus, operated by Harlow's School Bus Service

**Driver No. 1:** Terrence Johnson; 65; Belfield, ND; no injury

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**Charges:** None

**Passengers:** Dickinson State University Football Team; 38 players and coaches; no injuries

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2006 Lincoln Navigator

**Driver No. 2:** Miguel Gascal; male; 64; Mesquite, NV; injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use, airbags deployed

**Charges:** Under investigation

**Passenger No. 1:** Amalia Vasquez; female; 62; Michoacan, Mexico; injured

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**NARRATIVE:** While traveling east on I-94 near Crystal Springs, Gascal lost control of his vehicle on an icy bridge. Gascal's vehicle entered the median and then came back onto the eastbound lane. Gascal's vehicle was then struck by the bus. Both vehicles came to rest in the south ditch. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
