

Two Vehicle Injury Crash

What: 2 Vehicle Injury Crash

Where: Highway 2 near mile marker 13 (West of Williston, ND)

When: 11/21/2021 at approximately 2136 hours CST

Road Conditions: Clear, dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Semi vs SUV

Type of Crash: sideswiped, front to rear

Agencies Involved: Williston Rural Fire, Williston Ambulance, Williams County Sheriff's Office

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe – WCSO Patrol Vehicle

Driver No. 1: 35 year old male, Williston, ND, Minor injuries

Restraints: Unknown

Vehicle No. 2: 2014 Kenworth Truck Tractor hauling a tanker trailer

Driver No. 2: 25 year old male, Hot Spring, AR, uninjured

Restraints: Seatbelt in Use

NARRATIVE:

2014 Kenworth was traveling eastbound on Hwy 2 in the right lane in front of the Chevrolet Tahoe. There was an unknown vehicle traveling eastbound between the Kenworth and Chevrolet Tahoe. The Kenworth began to slow and signaled to turn south onto 142nd Ave NW. The unknown vehicle quickly moved into the left lane. The Chevrolet Tahoe swerved left to avoid the striking the Kenworth. The passenger side of the Chevrolet Tahoe sideswiped the driver side of the rear end protection of the trailer. The Tahoe came to rest on the shoulder of the left lane. The Kenworth turned south on 142nd Ave and came to rest. The driver of the Chevrolet Tahoe was transported by ambulance to CHI St. Alexis Health in Williston, ND. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
