Type of Crash: Angle, Roll over

Vehicle No. 1: 2004 Chevrolet Venture

Driver No. 1: 67 year old Female, Burlington, ND, Injured nonlife-threatening

Restraints: Seatbelt in Use

Vehicle No. 2: 2018 Ford Explorer - WCSO

Driver No. 2: 39 year old Male, Minot, ND, minor injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in Use

NARRATIVE:

The Patrol vehicle was traveling westbound on Hwy 2 with its emergency lights and sirens activated responding to an injury crash. The 2004 Chevrolet Venture was eastbound on Hwy 2 and turned northbound on 13th St. SE. As both vehicles entered the intersection, the Chevrolet Venture struck patrol vehicle. The patrol vehicle traveled northwest struck a pole, overturned, and came to rest. The Chevrolet came to rest in the intersection. Traffic was detoured for approximately an hour and a half. The crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
