Pedestrian/Vehicle Crash

What: Serious Injury Crash

Where: ND 23, Mile Marker 68, 3 miles northeast of Parshall

When: 9/13/2021 at approximately 0530

Road Conditions: Asphalt – dry

Weather Conditions: Clear, dark, not lighted

Crash Involvement: Two vehicle, one pedestrian

Type of Crash: Vehicle-Pedestrian

Agencies Involved: ND Highway Patrol, Mountrail County Sheriff, Three Affiliated Tribes Police Department, Parshall Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: Grey 2019 Ford F-450

Driver No. 1: Arnold Aga, 60-year-old male, Granville, ND NOT INJURED

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Vehicle No. 2: Silver 2003 Nissan Murano

Driver No. 2: Jeffrey Hanah, 58-year-old male, Minot, ND NOT INJURED

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Vehicle 2 Passenger 1: Ryan Dohmsreich, 38-year-old male, Minot, ND NOT INJURED

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Vehicle 2 Passenger 2: Nathan Kluegel, 30-year-old male, Minot, ND NOT INJURED

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Pedestrian: Shulton Royce Heart, 49-year-old male, Parshall, ND SERIOUS INJURIES

NARRATIVE:

Both vehicles were traveling west on ND-23. A pedestrian, wearing dark clothing, was walking west on the center line of ND-23. The area was dark and not lighted by streetlights. The Ford struck the pedestrian with left mirror, which knocked the pedestrian down. The Nissan drove over the pedestrian as he laid on the roadway. The pedestrian was transported by ambulance to Trinity Hospital in Minot. The pedestrian sustained serious injuries. This incident is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
