West Fargo Bicycle Vehicle Crash

What: Bicycle motor vehicle crash, critical injury

Where: 800 block 33rd Ave E, West Fargo

When: Sunday, 09/26/2021, approximately 4:26 PM CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear/Sunny

Crash Involvement: Bicycle/Motor Vehicle

Type of Crash: Angle (T-Bone)

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, West Fargo Police Department, FM Ambulance, West Fargo Fire Department.

Vehicle No. 1: 2012 Subaru Forrester

Driver No. 1: Kyle Joseph Heying; male; age 21; of West Fargo, ND; no injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt worn; airbags not deployed

Charges: Under investigation

Vehicle No. 2: Roadmaster Granite Peak mountain bike

Driver No. 2: Juvenile male; age 13; of West Fargo, ND; critically injured.

Restraints: No helmet

Charges: None

NARRATIVE: The juvenile was riding his bike southbound on 8th ST E and crossing 33rd Ave E in West Fargo. The bicycle was being ridden between sidewalks. The Subaru was eastbound on 33rd Ave E and did not see the bicycle crossing the roadway. The front driver side bumper struck the bicycle/rider on his right-handed side. The juvenile came to rest in the intersection of 8th ST E and 33rd Ave E. The juvenile suffered serious injuries and was transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo. He remains in critical condition. Kyle Heying was not injured in the crash. The Subaru sustained damage to its front bumper. The crash remains under

investigation by the NDHP and the West Fargo Police Department. The Juvenile will not be identified.
