

## Injury Crash 3 Miles south of Fortuna

**What:** Injury

**Where:** 96th street 3 miles south of Fortuna

**When:** 09-28-2021 1000 hours

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Clear/Sunny

**Crash Involvement:** 2 Vehicle

**Type of Crash** Rear end

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Divide County Sheriff, Grenora Ambulance/Fire

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2016 Ford F-250 pulling trailer  
**Driver No. 1:** Luke Ashley Clinton-22 Florence, MO  
**Restraints:** seatbelt used  
**Charges:** cited for following to close

**Vehicle No. 2:** 1992 GMC Flatbed  
**Driver No. 2:** David Allen Walker-40 Crosby, ND  
**Restraints:** seatbelt used  
**Charges:** no charges were filled

**NARRATIVE:** The GMC flatbed truck, driven by Walker, was traveling eastbound on 96<sup>th</sup> street 3 miles south of Fortuna. The Ford F250, driven by Luke Clinton, was traveling eastbound pulling a trailer. Both vehicles were part of a larger work convoy. Visibility was reduced from dust on the gravel roadway. Clinton did not see that the GMC was traveling at a lower speed than his vehicle and rear ended the GMC.

Clinton was trapped in the Ford F250 because of the damage sustained to the vehicle. Clinton was extracted by the Grenora Fire Department. Clinton sustained serious but

none-life threatening injuries and was transported by ambulance to the CHI Hospital in Williston, ND. Clinton was cited for following to close. Walker was not injured in the crash.
