2 Vehicle Property Crash Caused by Medical Condition

NARRATIVE: The Kenworth semi was westbound on I-94. The driver, Michael Jones, is believed to have suffered a medical condition while driving causing him to lose control of the vehicle. The Kenworth crossed the median and entered the eastbound lane of I-94, striking the eastbound Kia Sedona before entering the south ditch. The occupants of the Kia were uninjured. The driver of the Kenworth was taken to Jamestown Regional Medical Center due to the medical condition.
