## **Injury Crash near Portland, ND**

**What:** Injury

**Where:** ND Highway 18, approximately 2.5 miles west of Portland, ND

**When:** 04/11/2022 at approximately 2:15 AM

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Single-vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

**Agencies Involved:** NDHP, Traill County Sheriff's Office, West Traill Ambulance, Portland Fire,

Sanford Aired

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2009 Toyota Camry

**Driver No. 1:** Skylar Robinson; male; age 30; of Mayville, ND; serious injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt not worn

**Charges:** DUI

**Passenger No. 1:** Ashley Feltus; female; age 31; of Mayville, ND; non-life-threatening injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt in use

**NARRATIVE:** Robinson was driving the Camry east on ND Highway 18, navigating a right-hand curve. Robinson lost control, and the Camry entered the south ditch where it rolled. Robinson was not wearing a seat belt and was ejected. He sustained serious injuries and was airlifted to Sanford Hospital in Fargo, ND. Feltus was wearing a seat belt and sustained non-life-threatening injuries. She was transported by ambulance to Sanford Mayville Medical Center in Mayville, ND.



The crash remains under investigation by the Highway Patrol.
